

Dr Sarah Borwein is a Canadian physician who has lived and worked in Hong Kong and Beijing for more than 24 years. She worked as a staff physician at the Beijing United Family Hospital where she was Director of Infection Control during the SARS outbreak in 2003. After returning to Hong Kong, she became a founding partner in 2005 of what is now a large multi-disciplinary medical group, where she practised until 2021.

Although she practises across the full family medicine spectrum, her special interests include travel & tropical medicine, infectious diseases, women's health, preventive medicine, and mental health.
